

**“Spoon of World”～Local Food Festa of the World～**  
**Terms and Conditions for Opening Stalls**

- Date and Time: Sunday, 24 March 2024 10:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.
- Venue: Convention Hall in B-con Plaza

1. Outline of “Spoon of World”

This is an event to "connect the world through food" to be held in Beppu City, where students from over 100 countries and regions around the world study.

The event aims to promote multicultural coexistence through **food and cultural exchanges among various countries**.

There will also be stage events and introduction of various countries' cultures at the venue.

2. Eligibility and requirements for stalls

- (1) Applications cannot be made by persons who are members of organized crime groups, persons affiliated with organized crime groups or similar organizations, or persons who have a close relationship with such persons.
- (2) Groups whose representative is under 20 years of age are not eligible to apply.
- (3) Alcohol sales are not permitted.
- (4) Only those who have not received any administrative sanctions for food poisoning or food sanitation problems in the past 5 years are eligible to apply.
- (5) Please include at least one local food item (outside of Japan) that costs less than 500 yen including tax. ※State the name of the country of the local food. We plan to have about 30 stalls, and we may make adjustments in case of duplication of country names, etc.

4. Booth fee

Free of charge

Note: **You must pay 5,000 yen booth deposit fee per booth in advance.**

This fee will be refunded on the day of the event to those who have opened a stall.

Attendance at the vendor briefing is mandatory.

6. Proxy vendors

No proxy vendor other than the applicant will be allowed to open a stall on behalf of the applicant. In addition, if a vendor violates the terms and conditions by renting or reselling a stall under his/her own name, he/she will be asked to leave the venue immediately.

7. Disruptive behavior and violation of rules

If a vendor is deemed necessary to leave the venue during the event due to disruptive behavior or violation of rules, the vendor will be asked to leave the venue immediately.

(3) Selling hours

10:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. (Hours are subject to change)

(4) Removal and clean-up

4:00 - 6:00 p.m.

- (5) After entering through the gate on the east side of B-con Plaza and unloading your belongings at the designated area, please move your car to the designated parking lot as soon as possible. Please be sure to display your parking ticket in a position where the staff can see your name and number from the outside of your car, and follow the instructions of the staff when passing through.
- (6) No fires, including portable stoves, are allowed to be used in the Convention Hall. However, fire can be used only in the open-air tent (space area: 3.6m x 2.7m) on the north side of the Convention Hall. So, please contact the Executive Committee Secretariat (Cultural and International Affairs Division) if you wish to use the space.
- (7) The secretariat will take care of garbage such as "disposable containers," "splittable chopsticks," and "spoons" that participants will use, but please be sure to take all garbage from each booth home with you.
- (8) The booth area will be 2.7m x 2.7m. The secretariat will provide 4 long tables (1.8m x 0.45m), 4 chairs, a booth menu sign (2.7m x 0.3m) to display items for sale, and an portable electric cooker (1 to 1.2kW, capable of boiling, steaming, baking, and frying).
