

We are fighting against the “virus”, not a “person”.

◆ In the city, since some foreign students have been infected by the COVID-19 disease, there have been cases of unilateral refusal of foreign students to enter the restaurants or shops.

Such actions are **clearly discriminatory!**

◆ Those who are infected will be treated at medical facilities under the supervision of the prefecture, and those who have been in close contact with the infected patients will be kept at home for 14 days for health checks.

◆ The patients will need to concentrate on their cure and their contact with the outside world will be limited until the risk to infect other people is eliminated.

◆ Nationality is not a factor in the new coronavirus infection. The risk of infection is the same for Japanese and foreigners.

◆ Please do not refuse to enter the restaurants or shops based on the visitor's appearance, for example, “Because they are foreign students...” or “Because they look like foreigners...”.

◆ It is important **to learn and understand the correct information** about the new coronavirus infection.

◆ One of the charms of Beppu is that a diverse group of people come together to enliven the city.

◆ We live, learn, and work together in Beppu.
